## Four Frequently Asked Questions about Partners for Healthy Students

### 1. How can I be sure if my children qualify for Partners for Healthy Students?

Give us a call! It's the best way to learn about our services and to discuss eligibility. In the meantime, here's a look at our eligibility requirements.

#### School-Based Kids Health Clinics

No health insurance or insurance with both:

- A deductible over \$2,500
- No co-pays before health insurance will cover medical expenses

#### Mobile Kids Health Clinic

- No health insurance
- Health insurance with a high deductible
- Children with AHCCCS or KidsCare are eligible

### 2. Is there any cost to participate in Partners for Healthy Students?

No. Partners for Healthy Students delivers no-cost healthcare in its clinics.

### 3. What medical services are provided by Partners for Healthy Students?

Children receive high quality healthcare services from a Certified Pediatric Nurse Practitioner. Services available through YRMC's Partners for Healthy Students, include:

- Wellness and Prevention Visits
- Exams, Diagnoses and Treatment for Illness
- Sports Physicals
- Prescriptions for Acute Illnesses
- Referrals to Community Services
- Immunizations

### 4. How do I make an appointment or ask questions about the services?

Simply call (928) 771-5662 or (928) 771-5123 and you will reach a Partners for Healthy Students staff member who will be able to answer questions and/or schedule an appointment.
