

Program Information

Welcome to Yavapai Regional Medical Center's Partners for Healthy Students School-Based Clinics. We are glad you are interested in your child's health and we can work together to keep your child healthy, active and in school. Your child will receive health services from a Certified Pediatric Nurse Practitioner and it is required that a parent/legal guardian be in attendance with their child at the visit.

The following services will be available for your child:

- Wellness/Prevention visits
- Examination, diagnoses, and treatment of illnesses
- Appropriate basic laboratory tests and x-rays upon Partners for Healthy Students' Nurse Practitioner referral
- Medications

The following services or payment for services will not be provided:

- Follow-up or ongoing care by referral specialists or physicians
- Treatment in the YRMC Emergency Department
- Emergency treatments at any other health care facility
- Hospitalization
- Reproductive health services or counseling
- Ambulance services
- Treatment of mental health problems
- Emergent orthopedic problems or lacerations

The services provided by the PHS Clinic will be at no cost to the family and by appointment only. The parent/legal guardian must be in attendance for the child to be seen in the PHS Clinic. Medications for acute illnesses will be provided at no charge by YRMC.

All medical records will be kept by YRMC and confidentiality will be maintained according to YRMC policy. The medical record will be available to the Nurse Practitioner, nurses and physicians at YRMC. Parents/legal guardians may access their child's medical record at any time in accordance with YRMC policy. No records will be released without parent/legal guardian written authorization.

If the parent would like to make an appointment, they may call (928) 771-5662, the PHS office at YRMC, or (928) 771-5123 for the PHS Mobile Kids Health Clinic. Clinic visits are by appointment only.

An important aspect of our program is the assessment of the PHS program's impact on the health status of the student population. Parent/legal guardian/student participation in health surveys or other forms of evaluation is requested and appreciated.
