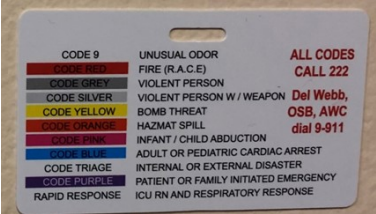
New names for our Imaging Centers
